As the first cyber university in Korea, the Cyber University of Korea (CUK) was established in 2001 by Dr. Byung Kwan Kim, the former chairman of the Korea Choongang Education Foundation. CUK carries on the educational spirit and long tradition of Korea University (KU) in cyber space, which belongs to the Korea Choongang Education Foundation and is a prestigious university in Korea. The educational philosophy of CUK is to pursue “Creativity and Service” to the society and the world, and CUK strives to play a leading role in lifelong education, contribute to higher universal education and reform higher education to realize its philosophy. In addition, CUK specifically cooperates with KU in developing educational programs such as K-MOOC (Massive Open Online Course) programs and sharing student facilities such as libraries, museums, and hospitals.





The Graduate School of Interdisciplinary Information Studies

The graduate school awards Masters of Informatics in three fields of study: Education Informatics, Business Informatics, and Technology Informatics.

Smart Campus

We have CUK Learning Management System, an interactive and convenient interface that enables students to check attendance and curriculums on their mobile devices and personal computers.



Virtual Campus

We are the first university to offer cyber engineering education since 2013, and have the largest division of engineering study compared to any other cyber universities in Korea. We built a simulation based online virtual lab on cloud environments and established an academic tie with the College of Science of KU to develop innovative engineering courses.

Practical Education

We provide about 200 professional certification and training courses with field-oriented practical education. We also offer Blended Learning that combines online digital media with offline educational methods for better educational service.

We are proud of the fact that foremost specialists from various areas are involved in developing and offering professional courses based on their field experience. We have lectures given by 250 excellent faculty members and research staff. We also have about 200 leading experts, who provide special lectures to share their brilliant knowledge and skills.

In response to the demand, we set a goal to cultivate talents with a spirit of humanity and social contribution and are actively participating in a wide range of social services.

CUK Voluntary Service

We are engaged in diverse voluntary services based on love for humanity. We regularly visit welfare facilities to help the disabled and disadvantaged youths and offer international students Korean Language-learning Mentoring Service for free. We are planning to set up the CUK Volunteers as the representative voluntary group of CUK promoting the spirit of sharing.



CUK Campaigns

With the Rosalynn Carter Institute for Caregiving (RCI), we have developed the Caregiving Training Program designed to foster caregivers who help suffering patients from dementia or chronic disease and promoted related educational campaigns since 2010. Furthermore, we carry on e-Learning Campaign for Multicultural Families and provide Quick Korean, the free online Korean language-learning program, to support immigrant’s adaptation in Korean society.

CUK Global Networks

Through global educational partnership, we contribute to creating online learning programs suitable for each country’s educational environment and broadening our educational horizons. In particular, we have partnership with Georgia Southwestern State University (U.S.), the University of Tennessee at Martin (U.S.), University of Newcastle (U.K.), University of Language and International Studies of VNU (Vietnam), Kindai University (Japan), Fudan University (China), and more.



The Free online Korean Language-learning Program

A growing number of people around the world now try to learn Korean language and culture following the Korean Wave hitting the world. As immigrant population increases in Korea, especially foreign workers and brides who married Korean men, social support for them to overcome language barriers and adjust in Korean society becomes essential. To this end, CUK offers the free e-Learning Campaign for Multicultural Families and the Quick Korean to anyone who needs to learn Korean language and culture.

Level 1 is taught in Korean, English, Japanese, Chinese and Spanish. It is also provided with Thai subtitles. Levels 2, 3, and 4 are offered with Korean, English and Chinese subtitles. With these multi-language services, users from 190 countries including the United States, Thailand, Brazil, China, and Spain are currently learning Korean language via "Quick Korean." Such programs have reached 4.5 million hits on YouTube.

Educational Efficiency of Quick Korean

“Quick Korean is special for its well-organized learning process and approach.”

Firstly, Quick Korean systematically consists of 4 levels from elementary to advanced courses so that learners can study Korean language according to their ability. Anyone who studies all the way through Level 4 may be prepared to attain a Level 3.5 on TOPIK, the exam of Korean language proficiency.

Secondly, Quick Korean focuses on the daily life of Korean families from its dialogues consisting of housewives, businessmen, students and teenagers. Learners can thus easily study casual daily conversation and vividly experience Korean life.

Thirdly, Quick Korean provides visually effective lectures using electronic bulletin boards and animated films. It also includes other various learning formats such as web-assisted learning kits and textbooks.
